- 1. Home visits to support families at the time of bereavement before and after and to support the elderly who are unable to come to the temple
- 2. Hospital visits and regular follow ups to support ailing Vaisnavas.
- 3. Assist elderly devotees at the prasad serve out during the Love Feast.
- 4. Grocery distribution to needy devotees in conjunction with support from Food For Life
- 5. Ensure devotees have a funeral cover and a updated will.
- 6. Coordinate funerals and 3rd day memorials.
- 7. Transport devotees to and from temple, doctors, hospitals.
- 8. Try and uplift the living condition of the devotee.

The secret to these light muffins is to avoid over mixing the batter.

Crumble Ingredients 100g cake flour 50g brown sugar 50g butter

Muffin Ingredients 500g self-raising flour 60g almond powder (ground almonds) 1 tsp baking soda 1 tsp baking powder 250g caster sugar 2 cups milk 320ml sunflower oil 2 tsp vanilla essence

1 tsp blueberry essence (Blueberry essence is obtainable at Bake-a-ton for KZN readers and Linda's Bake and Pack for Gauteng readers) 125g fresh blueberries (if using frozen blueberries allow to thaw fully before using) 1/3 Cup flaked almonds

Method

Mix crumble ingredients with your fingertips until you have a lumpy crumble mixture. Set aside. Mix together all the dry ingredients in a large bowl. In a large jug whisk together the wet ingredients until combined. Pour the wet ingredients into the dry ingredients together with the blueberries and using a quick action mix together until just combined (about 10 to 20 seconds). The mixture should still be a bit lumpy. Avoid the urge to over mix the batter as it will result in a tough muffin.

Spoon the mixture into 24 regular sized muffin cups. Sprinkle over the crumble and flaked almonds and bake at 180°C for 20 minutes or until the muffins are lightly golden. Offer to Krishna with love and devotion and then serve.






